Human Hair DNA Test

Positive; Based on samples of hair from the deceased, as provided by the police; tests confirm that hair found on the staircase belonged to Reynard Armstrong.

Human Hair DNA Test

Based on DNA samples provided by the police, tests confirm that additional hair found on the staircase belonged to Miyuki Miura. No other human hair was discovered in the samples provided.

Animal Hair DNA Test

Based on fur samples provided by the police, tests confirm that animal hair found on the staircase belonged to the deceased's pet cat. No other animal hair was discovered in the samples provided.

Blood Spatter Test

Negative; Confirmed substance: cat urine; Surfaces splattered with cat urine can look deceptively like someone has attempted to clean up blood when viewed under ultra violet light.

Footprint Analysis

Positive; Plaster cast and photos supplied by the police are a definite match to the evidence [a single boot] with a probability of 97%.

Toxicology Test

Negative; Chocolates and tea provided by the police failed to show any trace of toxic compounds when screened for typical poison array.
